IMMERSE YOURSELF IN HISTORY AND FUN

Centennial [sen-ten-ee-uhl] noun: a 100th anniversary or its celebration. No matter how it's defined, a 100th birthday is certainly cause for celebration! And in 2019, The Butler Institute of American Art reaches this milestone with plans for special exhibits, activities and events, including a special celebratory Gala in October.

Founded by Youngstown industrialist Joseph G. Butler Jr. to house his extensive collection of American Art, The Butler opened to the public in October 1919. It was established as the first museum in the country dedicated to works created solely by American Artists. It was founded "pro bono publico" (for the public good) and has maintained its free admission policy throughout its history.

Known worldwide as "America's Museum," its holdings now exceed 20,000 individual pieces in all media, covering four centuries of work. The Butler's permanent collection is a true

reflection of America's history, arranged in chronological order. Director and Curator, Dr. Louis Zona, has been known to say, "A visit to The Butler is like a walk through American history, with masterpieces leading the way."

Browsing through the museum's marbled halls, you'll find important paintings by Mary Cassatt, John Singer Sargent, Edward Hopper and William Merritt Chase, to name just a few. You will also find Snap the Whip by Winslow Homer, the centerpiece of the museum's 19th century holdings. This painting of children playing outside of a one-room school house is known as "America's Mona Lisa". All are part of the museum's impressive collection of realist portraits, impressionist pieces and paintings of the American West.

Explore the Beecher Center which features new media and electronic art. Works of art that utilize computer, holography, lasers and other digital

mediums are displayed here. In contrast to these modern pieces, when you cross the glass skywalk to Butler North, you'll find yourself in the Americana/Folk Art Galleries. On view are primitive paintings from the Colonial Era, carousel horses, ship models, decoys and a glass bell collection.

Throughout its 100 years, The Butler has also welcomed a wide variety of temporary exhibits and memorable traveling art. There is always something new to see. You'll want to plan a full day to explore all the galleries. Happy Birthday **Butler Art!**

Want to learn more about Youngstown's history as the second-largest steel producer in the US? A visit to The Youngstown Historical Center of Industry & Labor will give you a glimpse into the lives and times of the men and women who labored in the iron and steel industry in the Mahoning Valley, Known locally as The Steel Museum, this unique facility preserves this area's labor, immigration and urban history. While artifacts like workers' tools and clothing lend a closer look into the lives of past steel mill workers. life-sized scenes. including a mill locker room and part of a company-built house, give an accurate depiction of life during the steel era.

The steel industry brought great wealth and prosperity to Youngstown, which is reflected at The Arms Family Museum. Built in 1905, this Arts and Crafts-style mansion features original period rooms that highlight handicraft, medieval architecture and the natural environment. Other levels feature exhibits that explore life in the Mahoning Valley. Visit during the holidays to see the spectacular Memories of Christmas Past.

Bring your kids to OH WOW! Children's Center for Science & Technology for hands-on. STEM-based EDUtainment! FUN is the name of the game at this fantastic facility in downtown Youngstown. Children and adults can explore and play in an environment that fosters independent thinking and learning through interactive exhibits. Eleven WOW! Zones, more than 60 exhibits and the hands-on InspireWorks! Lab make for a wonderful experience for children ages 0-14. You're guaranteed to have a WOWtastic time at OH WOW! Glistening lakes, winding trails, pristine golf courses and beautiful gardens are just a few of the things you'll find while exploring **Mill Creek MetroParks**. Established in 1891 by Volney Rogers, Mill Creek Park was named the first park district in Ohio, encompassing over 2,000 of the MetroParks' 4,500+ acres.

Spanning across most of Mahoning County, Mill Creek is a must-visit destination for anyone exploring the area. And with countless things to do and see in the park, one visitor's trip may look completely different from another's. Your first step to visiting Mill Creek MetroParks? Identify the type of traveler you are! Your next step? Explore the beauty of Mill Creek...

As a Family

With young ones in tow, head to the Wick Recreation Area. It includes a new Dek Hockey rink, multiple playgrounds, a Par-3 golf course, batting cages, tennis and volleyball courts and ball fields. Then, let the kids cool off at the splash pad. If your kids love the snow, the Sled Hill located here is a blast! It's the best in the area. Ford Nature Center is a fun stop for the kids, and will soon undergo a renovation. Animal lovers? Spend some time at the MetroParks Farm! The 402-acre farm is home to several animal barns, a children's playroom and archery range. You'll also find educational programming and special events throughout the year.




As a Photographer

Mill Creek MetroParks Experimental Farm

You'll find photo opportunities galore throughout Mill Creek Park. Make sure to get a picture of the iconic Lanterman's Mill and Covered Bridge. The best location to capture this historic mill, waterfall, bridge and surrounding landscape is from the Canfield Road bridge which offers a perfect overlook. Then, go inside to see how the mill functions just as it did in the mid-1800s. The Park's steel Suspension Bridge, or Cinderella Bridge, is also worth a visit. Its unique architecture has been the backdrop to many photoshoots-and for good reason! A stop at beautiful Fellows Riverside Gardens is an absolute must. This 12-acre public display garden features beautiful landscapes, scenic vistas and the roses are spectacular!

As an Outdoor Enthusiast

Get your workout in surrounded by nature's beauty. Take a brisk (or leisurely) walk, or challenge yourself to a tough run on 45 miles of paved and unpaved hiking trails. Pedal your way through the 11-mile **MetroParks Bikeway**. Kayak on **Lake Glacier** or **Lake Newport**. Tee off on one of two 18-hole championship **golf courses**, designed by Donald Ross.



And play a game of pickleball, volleyball or tennis on one of the park's many courts.

As a Bird Buff

Mill Creek's **Wildlife Sanctuary** is the perfect stop for bird watching. It's a 264-acre former fish farm that supports a diverse array of aquatic, wetland and upland habitats. More than 225 species of birds have been documented here. The Sanctuary is an important resting point during migration months. Bring binoculars or spotting scopes and identify species from the convenient observation platform.

through the seasons



In the spring, visit the 12-acre Fellows Riverside Gardens or take a walk through Daffodil Meadow. You'll find thousands of tulips in full bloom. Dog owner? Join MetroMutts and participate in the program's many spring dog hikes.



During summertime, tee off on one of Mill Creek's two golf courses, paddle the day away in a rented kayak or go for a hike. Give the kids a break from the heat at the park's splash pad and enjoy an evening Summer Concert Series performance.



In the fall, take a hike or bike ride on one of the park's trails lined with colorful trees or snap a photo in front of Lanterman's Mill. In October, carve pumpkins at Fellows Riverside Gardens, then see them displayed at the Pumpkin Walk at Twilight.



During the winter, ice skate on the park's outdoor rink or take a ride down the Sled Hill. Adventurous? Cross-country ski on one of the many courses throughout the park. Or escape the cold and sign up for an indoor yoga session.

A family-friendly recreational area located in Mill Creek MetroParks, the Wick Recreation Area offers wet, adventure, sand and tot playgrounds with interactive equipment, batting cages, Par 3 golf course, disc golf, volleyball and tennis courts, softball and soccer fields, an outdoor amphitheater and a sled riding hill for year-round fun.

You'll also find Dek Hockey which is played on foot or with inline skates, using a ball instead of a puck. Mill Creek MetroParks, the Youngstown Phantoms Hockey Team and the Pittsburgh Penguins Foundation have installed a street hockey rink at the Wick Recreation Area.

MILL CREEK METROPARKS BIKEWAY

The MetroParks Bikeway is an 11-mile paved trail and offers a variety of scenery. The Kirk Road Trailhead, located near the midpoint of the Bikeway, has a parking lot, restrooms, water fountains and picnic pavilion.

STAVICH BICYCLE TRAIL

The only bicycle trail in the US that takes cyclists through two states. This 12-mile trail originates in Struthers on the western end and continues east to New Castle, PA. It runs parallel to the scenic Mahoning River and the former Youngstown-New Castle streetcar line.

LAKE MILTON MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL

For those who prefer to take the path less traveled, the Lake Milton Mountain Bike Trail is a developing, obstacle-free trail. Currently the trail is six miles and upon completion it will be 10 to 12 miles. The trail has tight turns, short, punchy climbs and descents. It is ridden as an out-and-back and rides great in both directions. Trailhead can be found off Ellsworth Road near the southeast corner of the lake.

Youngstown's Newest Entertainment Venue: The Youngstown Foundation Amphitheatre

Schedules are set, shovels have struck ground and hopes are high for the newest addition to downtown Youngstown: The Youngstown Foundation Amphiteatre. Slated to open in the summer of 2019, this massive outdoor venue will sit inside the newly-curated Riverfront Park with views of downtown and the bordering Mahoning River.

The Youngstown Foundation Amphitheatre will be a regional entertainment destination hosting a variety of happenings, from community events, to national touring artists, to music festivals. The space includes three buildings, totaling 5,000 square feet, an expansive state-of-the-art stage, high-quality sound system, lighting and multiple concession areas. Once completed, up to 4,800 visitors will have the option to sit in the amphitheatre's flexible hard seating area in front of the stage, mingle on the grass lawn or get up-close-and-personal with their favorite artists from the designated VIP area.

Where exactly will you find The Youngstown Foundation Amphitheatre? Right inside the 12-acre Riverfront Park.

Situated along the Mahoning River, the park spans from the South Avenue Bridge to just west of Hazel Street. This new green space will not only provide Downtown Youngstown's citydwellers with a much-needed natural refuge, but will also connect nature-lovers to the city with a 2.3-mile hike and bike trail from Mill Creek Park to the Central Business District.

As the fourth oldest community foundation in the country and ranked top 100 nationally, The Youngstown Foundation is one of the founding partners and a major contributor to the amphitheatre project. Since its inception in 1918, the Foundation has facilitated more than \$110 million in charitable funds and awarded more than \$6 million in grants annually. This year, to commemorate the Foundation's 100th year, a \$3 million grant was gifted to the amphitheatre project. The grant not only greatly impacted the construction of the amphitheatre, but also secured naming rights to the new facility for 20 years.

This summer, The Youngstown Foundation Amphitheatre will provide the opportunity for locals and visitors alike to experience the revitalized energy known and loved in Downtown Youngstown.


